### ABOUT BOSTON



Boston, the capital city of Massachusetts, is a popular tourist destination that boasts a rich history and culture. There are several must-visit places in Boston that should be on any traveler's itinerary. #### ISABELLA STEWART GARDNER MUSEUM
